**IMPORTANT QUESTIONS TO ASK WHEN CHOOSING A
CONTRACTOR**

- 1) Do you subcontract work? If work is subcontracted, does contractor require and have on file a subcontractor Certificate of Insurance from the insurance carrier to assure you as a homeowner, that you are covered should an accident occur. **Paitson Roofing Co., Inc. does not subcontract** and will furnish a Certificate of Insurance upon request.
- 2) Are roofing shingles hand nailed or machine nailed? Paitson Roofing hand nails all roofing shingles to assure our customers that nails are properly set.
- 3) What type of nail is used for roofing shingle applications? Paitson Roofing will provide an option for Maze U.S. StormGuard zinc-coated, corrosion-resistant roof nails in place of imported nails. Maze zinc-coated nails carry a Manufacturer's Lifetime Limited Warranty and have superior rust resistance and holding power due to zinc coating.
- 4) Is your contractor a member of the Better Business Bureau? If so, what rating does the company carry? Paitson Roofing Co., Inc. has an A+ rating, the highest available.
- 5) Does the contractor have an office and showroom with a permanent land line phone system to assure you they will be obtainable should you need them?
- 6) How long has contractor been in business? Paitson Roofing Co., Inc. has been in business since 1950.
- 7) Will contractor furnish you with an address for a job in progress, as you will be able to view workers and job quality? Paitson Roofing Co., Inc. will furnish you an address for a job in progress and would welcome you to view job and talk with our foreman and workers. Paitson Roofing only employs quality conscious foremen and workers, as no shortcuts are taken that could sacrifice quality.
- 8) How does contractor dispose of debris? Paitson Roofing Co., Inc. uses dump trailers on wheels to prevent driveway or yard damage from "setting dumpsters".
